To Play: Place one hand palm up for the "bed". Hold fingers up on your other hand, to indicate the number of monkeys. Bounce your fingers up and down on the "bed" to show the monkeys jumping. Hold up one finger to show that one monkey fell off. Grimace and hold a hand to your head to demonstrate the bump. Dial a phone with a one finger when the father calls the doctor. Shake your index finger to indicate "no, no" when the doctor speaks. **Variation:** The last line of verse 5 may be spoken instead of sung.
